SENIORS POINTS CHAMPIONSHIP	
General Information	
Point leader of the championship will receive a 2024 \$1,500 Seniors WSOP seat and money for travel expenses.	
Point Championship begins 2/6/24 through 6/7/24 (final date may be adjusted due to the WSOP schedule).	
Players may get points according to the following chart:	
60 points for 1st	12 points for 6th
40 points for 2nd	9 points for 7th
25 points for 3rd	7 points for 8th
18 points for 4th	5 points for 9th
15 points for 5th	2 points per entry
\$100 from each prize pool will be taken out for the Seniors Points Championship	
In the event of a tie, in points, total money won will be used as the tie breaker.	

Blinds will be raised until the completion of the tournament.

Buy-in consists of a \$30 tournament access fee, \$100 to the prize pool · The \$100 taken from the prize pool for the points championship is included in the tournament guarantee · There must be at least 5 players to start the tournament within 15 minutes of the scheduled start for the guarantee to be honored · Players may re-enter through the 1st break, players will have an option to forfeit their current chip stack up to the start of level 7 · A single ante will be paid from the big blind for each hand · The ante is paid after the big blind · The ante will not reduce.
