- BUY-IN FOR EVENT IS \$600. LADIES RECEIVE A 2/3<sup>RD</sup> DISCOUNT (\$400) ON THEIR ENTRY.

Of the \$200 Buy-In, \$40 will be withheld for Entry Fee. \$100 from the remaining entry will form the individual player prize pool and \$60 remaining from the entry will form the Team Prize Pool. Team Prize Pool is paid out 35% for 1st place team, 25% for 2nd, 17% for 3rd 13% for 4th and 10% for 5th. Individual Prize Pool is paid out as normal individual player payouts. Team Scoring begins with 100 players remaining in the field. At that point, each eliminated player is given a score based on their finish. The team with the highest overall score wins the team portion of the tournament and prize pool monies.

1. This will be a No-Limit Texas Hold'em tournament.
2. The buy-in for this event is \$600. All Ladies will receive a \$400 discount and may enter for \$200. All players will start with 25,000 in chips.
3. This will be a freeze-out tournament and will have no re-entry.
4. Players must pre-register with a full team with the tournament coordinator (Lupe Soto) before the tournament begins. A team representative, up to one hour before the tournament starts, will make payments for the whole team. They will be responsible for distributing seating assignments to their team. Submit seat requests when pre-registering the team. Only full teams of six players may enter.
5. Substitutions may be made for unique situations, however, a player is only allowed to play on one team and may only play one time in this event. They may not act as a substitute on another team if they have already played.
6. Players arriving after the start of the tournament acknowledges the tournament has already started, time has expired from the tournament clock and that the blinds may have been raised.
7. Players must be seated by the end of level two (2) or their chips will be removed from play and there will be no refund.
8. There will be two prize pools. \$100 from each entry will go to the individual prize pool and \$60 from each entry will go to the team prize pool. \$40 will be held for staff and house fees.
9. Play on day 1 will last until the end of level 18 or until only 50 players remain. If more than 50 players remain at the end of level 18 in 1A, then 1B will play down to an equal number of players. All remaining players will return on Thursday, April 23rd at 10:10 AM
10. Players finishing in the top 100 players will receive points towards the team prize pool. Points will be assigned as follows; 100=1, 99=2, 98=3...3=98, 2=99, 1=100. The team prize pool is paid out to the teams that accumulate the most points. 40% for 1<sup>st</sup>, 30% for 2<sup>nd</sup>, 20% to 3<sup>rd</sup>,
11. Prize Pool will be paid in casino chips.
12. You must be at least 21 years of age to participate.
13. Tournament Director Association ("TDA") rules will apply in all tournaments at the South Point. Copies of the TDA rules are available upon request as well as any variations specific to the South Point. If the TDA rules do not address the issue, South Point House rules will apply.
14. When making a decision in the tournament the floor staff will follow TDA rules whenever possible, but will consider all circumstances when making any decision. The decisions of South Point Poker Room management regarding all aspects of this tournament are final and binding.
